

DEVELOPMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE GUIDELINES

2004

The Board of Education delegates to the District Administrator the function of designing and implementing the guidelines, required actions, and detailed arrangements under which the District will operate. These administrative guidelines shall be consistent with the policies adopted by the Board.

The Board will formulate and adopt administrative guidelines and rules only when required by law, and when the District Administrator recommends Board adoption.

The District Administrator may issue such administrative and student handbooks as necessary for the effective administration of the schools.

Where administrative guidelines and handbooks are consistent with Board policies, or with Federal/State law, they will be considered to be an extension of the policy manual and binding upon all employees and students.
