

STUDENT HEALTH SERVICES

North Lake School recognizes and accepts its responsibility to initiate and monitor a school health room so that the health of its students and employees are given proper attention. To carry out this policy, the District Administrator shall consult with the Public Health Department and medical advisors in the development of appropriate procedures.

Health services are available to the students and staff during the regular school day in the school health room. American Red Cross certified volunteers will staff the health room. The health room policies and procedures are outlined in the handbook "North Lake School District Health Room Guidelines." This handbook is updated annually to assure current practices and procedures by a committee developed by the District Administrator. Pursuant to Wisconsin Statute 121.01(g), a registered nurse will be part of the reviewing committee. Arrangements will be made with a physician to serve as a medical advisor for the health services team.

Health services procedures shall include protocols for dealing with accidental injury and illness and administration of medication at all school-sponsored activities including, but not limited to, curricular, co-curricular, and extra-curricular activities and a method to record each incident of service provided.

Health services will be available during the regular school day and during all school-sponsored activities.

Emergency information cards, equipment, supplies and space for health services will be readily accessible.

All parents/guardians shall be required to complete a student emergency card each school year. It is the obligation of the parents/guardians to keep these cards current.

A list of students with special health needs will be compiled at the beginning of each school year and will be maintained in the health room.
