

HEALTH RELATED ABSENCES

4001.3

If a student becomes ill at school, his/her parents/guardians, or person designated by the respective parents, will be notified and asked to pick up the student. Parents/guardians or designees must come into the office to pick up the student.

A student will be sent home from school with a designated adult should any of the following occur:

- a. Vomitting
- b. Temperature of 100 degrees Fahrenheit or greater
- c. Diarrhea
- d. Symptoms of conjunctivitis
- e. Presence of head lice and/or nits (Refer to policy #4016 Head Lice)

Additionally, school personnel may request that a student be discharged from school for the day for other medical ailments.

Students may be excluded from school and/or school-related activities if they are suspected of, or diagnosed as, having a communicable disease that poses a significant health risk to others or that renders them unable to adequately pursue their studies. Students excluded from school pursuant to this policy may appeal their exclusion as set forth in established administrative procedures.
