An Emergency Crisis Procedure Manual will be developed, maintained, and approved by the North Lake School District to serve in protecting life, property, and the public trust. The District Administrator is directed to:

1. Work collaboratively with relevant stakeholders to review and update the Emergency Crisis Procedure Manual every three years or as need should arise. Any and all revisions to the manual will be approved by the School Board.
2. Ensure that the placement of the Emergency Crisis Procedure Manual is in each room of the school, and staff are familiar with the manual.
3. Ensure, either through personal initiative or delegation, that safety regulations and mandates required by law, are followed and maintained in a timely manner.
4. Ensure the use of, and follow the directives therein of, the School Board approved Emergency Crisis Procedure Manual in the event of an emergency.
