

TOBACCO-FREE ENVIRONMENT POLICY

4014

The North Lake School District is committed to practices that contribute to and model behaviors that stress wellness and healthful living practices. Smoking and other tobacco use has been identified by the Surgeon General of the United States as the number one health problem in the country. It is the leading cause of premature death, disease, and chronic disability.

Therefore, effective September 1, 1990, the use of any and all tobacco products shall be prohibited throughout the school building and on all school owned property. This ban encompasses all employees, students, patrons, visitors or any others attending school sponsored events and meetings, and shall be in effect at all times (24 hours a day).

The Board issues this ban in a sincere appeal to all employees, students and patrons to cooperate in helping to create a truly healthful environment within our facilities for all concerned. Enforcement of this policy will be via Town of Merton Ordinance Section 11.03.
