JOB GOAL: To help each participating student achieve an improved level of skill, an appreciation for the values of discipline and sportsmanship, and an increased level of self-esteem.

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QUALIFICATIONS: To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. Teachers contracted in the school district will be given priority consideration over non-contracted individuals. ~~The previous year coach will be given preference over a new candidate if all responsibilities were carried out satisfactorily.~~ Interviews for positions will be held if more than one candidate applies.

LANGUAGE SKILLS: Ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions, and procedure manuals. Ability to write routine reports and correspondence. Ability to speak effectively before groups of students, parents, and/or employees of the district. Exhibit qualities of leadership and organizational ability that reflects a spirit of cooperation in working with staff, parents, students, and school administration. Ability to communicate clearly and concisely both in oral and written form.

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PHYSICAL DEMANDS: The physical demands such as walking, standing, and occasionally running are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

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PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

* Coaches individual participants in the skills necessary for progress and achievement in the sport —involved.

* Plans and schedules a regular program of practices.

* Oversees the safety conditions of the facility or area in which assigned sport is conducted at all times —that students are present.

* Maintains ~~win/loss~~ statistical results of the season.

* Enforces discipline and sportsmanlike behavior at all times, and establishes and oversees penalties for —breach of

such standards by individual coaches and students. Technical fouls to the coach or players are unacceptable. ^{1*} The first technical will result in a meeting with the Activities Director. The second will result in a game suspension, the third will result in a two game suspension, and the fourth will result in removal from the team.

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* ~~Maintains professionalism, positive leadership, competency in rules, rule interpretations, meet procedures,~~ coaching techniques, and general coaching techniques, and general

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—information about all aspects of the sport. Coaches will coach from a seated position on the bench, except for when calling time-outs.

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* When possible, starters will be removed from playing when a North Lake basketball team is leading by 20 or more points. Every attempt will be made to control the pacing and scoring of the game in these situations.

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* Monitors the eligibility of players regarding academics, behavior, and other criteria as stated in the — North Lake

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School Activities Handbook.

* ~~Establishes a~~ Enacts the set criteria for playing time as stated in the North Lake School Activities Handbook.

* Adheres to a sound program of injury prevention and follow up.

* Recommends purchase of equipment, supplies, and uniforms.

* ~~Schedules all referees for home games.~~

* Accounts for all equipment.

* Supervises students of program at all times.

* Handles other duties as needed or assigned by administration.

* Upholds all Arrowhead Middle School Athletic Conference (AMSAC) rules.

* Coaches will be evaluated at the end of each season by athletes, parents, and administration.

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SPECIFIC SCHEDULE:

~~* The coach will schedule a minimum number of 20 contacts per season.~~

~~* The practice schedule will start at least ~~one-two~~ weeks before the regular games begin ~~or as allowed by~~ AMSAC rules.~~

~~* The coach will ~~develop a follow the~~ game schedule using the coordinated structure developed by ~~the consortium~~ AMSAC as a guide.~~
