

## **STUDENT CONDUCT**

**6008**

All student behavior should be based on respect and consideration for the rights of others. Students have a responsibility to know and follow the rules and regulations of the school and the Board approved code of classroom conduct.

Students have the further responsibility to behave in a manner appropriate to good citizenship everywhere. Any restrictions on student behavior must be concerned with speech or action that disrupts the work of the school or interferes with the rights of other students.

The Administrator is responsible for developing and administering reasonable rules and regulations for students. Such rules and regulations shall not conflict with Board policies, statutory law or case law.

The North Lake School District shall not discriminate in standards and rules of behavior including student harassment, on the basis of sex, race, religion, color, handicap, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
