

STUDENT ALCOHOL/DRUG ABUSE

6015

The use or possession of alcohol/drugs in or on school property, or at school events, and attendance at school events while under the influence of alcohol/drugs by students, is prohibited. A student may be required to submit to a breath test to determine the presence of alcohol if a law enforcement officer has reasonable suspicion that the student has alcohol in his/her system in violation of this policy. Such test shall be administered by a law enforcement officer and shall meet state law requirements. Parents will be contacted immediately if there is a suspicion of alcohol/drug use or possession.

Any student in violation of the provisions of the above paragraph shall be subject to prosecution in accordance with the provisions of the law.

Students attending school in the North Lake School District and in violation of the provisions of the paragraph above shall be subject to disciplinary actions in accordance with the provisions of the school regulations.

The North Lake School District recognizes that the use of alcohol/drugs illegally and/or inappropriately constitutes a hazard to the positive development of students. In addition to maintaining a realistic, meaningful alcohol/drug education program, the school shall be actively concerned with alcohol/drug use and abuse by students. Therefore, students will have available to them the benefits of counseling, the services of the school psychologist, and/or aide to contact approved out-of-school agencies.
