

MUSIC INSTRUCTION

To fulfill the mandates of Wisconsin Statutes and Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction mandates, the District Administrator shall implement the following plan regarding music instruction:

The District Administrator shall appoint a music committee composed of music teachers, a high school teacher and middle school teacher of another discipline, an elementary teacher and an administrator. The music committee shall submit to the District Administrator a music curriculum guide that shall be subsequently submitted to the Board and be subject to the Board's approval. The music committee shall annually review the curriculum guide and revise it as necessary. The music curriculum guide shall include a balanced and comprehensive music curriculum that includes developmental experiences involving singing, playing instruments, listening, movement, creative expression and music reading.

The administrative staff shall each year plan and implement inservice programs for all music teachers and elementary teachers. The inservice shall be devoted to music education and its relationship to other courses in the elementary curriculum.

Equipment and supplies necessary for the appropriate music instruction and inservice may be requisitioned and purchased by the District to ensure that the District's responsibilities adequately meet the needs of the music education program as mandated by Wisconsin Statutes and Department of Public Instruction mandates.

All students in grades K-6 shall be provided music instruction by a certified music teacher. Such students shall receive a minimum of one hour of music instruction by a certified music teacher each week. Music instruction shall be available on a semester basis for all students in grades 7-8 and shall be taught by a certified music teacher.
