The learning program shall be designed and operated so as to be developmental and to avoid the necessity for remedial education. Through personalized instructional methods and the use of a variety of resources, efforts shall be focused on making sure each student learns the skills, concepts, or content of each encounter with a new learning experience.

However, in those cases where students have clearly not achieved to the degree of their capability, every reasonable effort shall be made to remedy the situation by producing the learning results sought. Such efforts shall seek to avoid the simplistic approach of giving the student more and more of the same type of learning experiences that initially failed to produce the desired development.
