

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ATHLETICS

It shall be the policy of the Board to require each student who chooses to participate in an interscholastic athletic program to have on file in the school office a form of consent to participate which is signed by the parent or guardian of the student. In addition, a health form signed by the student's doctor must be on file in the school office. Parents may opt out of the physical examination requirement for religious reasons only after the approval of the District Administrator and the approval of the District liability carrier. This policy shall be in effect for each student for each sports season.

The district has a standing Athletic Committee and a Board approved Athletic Handbook. Specific procedures and guidelines for extra-curricular athletics are discussed in the handbook. Recommended changes to procedure go through the local Athletic Committee and then to the full Board. In addition, the Board will vote periodically on district participation in the Arrowhead Area Middle Level Athletic Conference.

It is the policy of the North Lake School District, pursuant to s. 118.13, Wis. Statutes., and PI 9, that no person, on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional, or learning disability, or a disability under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 may be denied admission to any school in this district or be denied participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be discriminated against in any curricular, extracurricular, pupil services, recreational, or other program. This policy applies to all school operations, including school-sponsored programs and activities.
