

TEXTBOOK SELECTION AND ADOPTION

It is the policy of the Board of Education to provide educational materials and equipment that support and enrich the curriculum and further the achievement to the District's instructional goals.

The selection of textbooks, supplementary books, and reference books is carried on continuously in order to keep up with the great expansion of knowledge and the rapid changes going on in our world today.

Insofar as possible, all textbooks should present balanced views concerning the international, national, and local issues and problems of our times.

The Administrator shall develop guidelines for the proper selection of textbooks for use in the North Lake School District. The Board shall adopt all textbooks necessary for use in the school and a list of the adopted books shall be filed with the Board Clerk.

No book shall be adopted for use or be used in the District's schools which falsifies the facts regarding the history of our nation, which defames our nation's founders or misrepresents the ideals and causes for which they struggled and sacrificed or which contains propaganda bias to any foreign government.

The North Lake School District shall not discriminate in the selection and evaluation of textbooks and supplementary materials on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
