

The IMC Director shall form a committee to draft a long-range plan for library services. This plan shall be subject to Board approval and include the following:

1. A statement of the current library/media program.
2. The District's objectives to be accomplished for library services. This must include a designated time period for the implementation of these objectives.
3. A process for evaluating the progress toward accomplishment of the District library/media objectives.

All students of the North Lake School District, as mandated by Wisconsin Statutes, shall be provided access to a current, balanced collection of books, basic reference materials, texts, periodicals, and audio-visual materials which depict in an accurate and unbiased way, the cultural diversity and pluralistic nature of American society.

The school shall have a central library to provide each student access to a collection of instructional materials. Such collections shall include instructional materials that offer sufficient range and variety in format, subject matter, level of sophistication and approach, as well as an unbiased point of view.

The North Lake School District shall not discriminate in selection and adoption of library materials and media on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
