The Board of Education recognizes that one of the greatest resources of the school is to be found in the people of the community who have special knowledge and particular talents to contribute to the school program. The Board, therefore, encourages the use of community resources and citizens to assist in furthering the educational program. The District Administrator should study the needs of his/her individual school, survey the resources available in the school community and weigh their probable usefulness.

Staff members utilizing the services of resource persons shall insure that these people are properly thanked for their contribution, either by means of students' letters or a note from the teacher.
