Carroll University's Prairie Springs Environmental Education Center and Greene Field Station is piloting their first ever nature-based summer camps. Water Detectives

Date: July 9-July 13

Description: Get ready to uncover the natural water wonders of Genesee Creek and the springs of the Greene Field Station as you become a Water Detective! Throughout the week, we will explore what makes freshwater so important for both plants and animals (including humans like us). We'll investigate wetlands, wade in the creek collecting macroinvertebrates, and discover how we can help to keep our waters clean.

Description: Get off the beaten path and join us for this week of outdoor adventures! Learn how to identify the plants and animals that call southeast Wisconsin home.
