WHAT: The North Lake Sailing School is awarding sailing instruction grants for two children attending North Lake Elementary School. Children must be 6 - 10 years old & interested in sailing to qualify. The classes are described below and all equipment will be included.

Opti Kinderpram: Designed for children, ages 5 & 6. This class will meet 5 Friday mornings a summer from 9:30 until noon with their mom, dad, or babysitter. The children will learn the parts of the optimist sailboat, sail in the boat with their guardian and gain comfort with the boat and the water. The Kinderpram class will visit popular spots around the lake and partake in various activities/games around North Lake, all after having navigated to their destination in their very own optimist sailboat. Class dates are 6/22, 6/29, 7/13, 7/12 & 7/27.

Learn to Sail 3-Week Opti Class: These sailors will have completed 1st Grade and are completely new to sailing. Students will go on various excursions around the lake as they increase their comfort level and mobility sailing their own optimist sailboat. This class will teach sailing terminology as well as the very basics of sailing including skills like rigging and de-rigging of the boat and reading wind direction. Class times are Monday and Wednesday from 1pm until 4pm and begin June 11 and end on June 27.

Learn to Sail Opti Camp: These sailors will follow the Learn to Sail 3-Week Class curriculum, but class will be held July 2-3 and July 5-6 from 9am until 2pm.

WHEN: A representative from North Lake Sailing School will be visiting on Friday, May 18 from 12:15 - 12:45pm during K - 4 scheduled lunch periods. Students will have the opportunity to ask questions and see the optimist sailboat that is used. Parents are welcome to attend as well. WHERE: Classes will be held at the North Lake Yacht Club on Northwoods Dr. - just a ½ mile from North Lake School.

WHY: Our mission is to encourage amateur sailing on the beautiful inland lakes. Not only is there an opportunity at the grade school level, but high school sailing is also a great way to be involved and establish friendships while doing something you enjoy.
