We are excited to begin preparations for our 9th annual “Literacy Lights the Night” event! This has been a popular and well attended event at NLS. We love the collaboration we’ve seen over the past number of years between teachers and parents in getting the students’ writing pieces ready to publish. For the new families who don’t know about Literacy Night, it is a voluntary outside of school activity where students in grades K-8 create a writing piece at home with parent support or with parent and teacher support at any or all of the four after-school writing workshops to be held in the library. Parents should assist and provide guidance with illustrations and editing for grammar, punctuation, and spelling so that that piece showcases your child’s best work. Teachers will provide the final “OK” to saying the piece is the students’ best work and it’s ready for everyone to see. Students then present their original writing piece in a group format at the Literacy Lights the Night Event on Thursday, February 7th.

Students will receive a t-shirt for participation in Literacy Night.
