# **Learn Spanish or German**

## **AFTER SCHOOL**

- Please see pp. 3-4 regarding <u>VIRTUAL</u> options for fall. I spent many hours this summer creating an entire virtual program.
- See pp. 1-2 for face to face Spanish class on Wednesdays and p. 5 for registration.
- If the face to face classes are canceled, your money for missed classes will be refunded, with the option of picking up the virtual class for a lesser fee.
- For now German will be offered only virtually.

Would your child enjoy an opportunity to take fun-filled Spanish classes after school at North Lake School? Instructor Jean Winkel has over 30 years of experience teaching Spanish and German as well as a Master's in Education.

Begin building a basic knowledge of Spanish through a study of introductory communication skills. Classes will include fun and meaningful games, songs, activities and additional immersion experience through cultural interaction. We will learn important phrases and emphasize conversation.

Classes take place from 2:30-3:30 pm, <u>5K-5th</u> grade, in the Spanish room.

#### **Due to Covid**

Class size will be limited (with a 4 student minimum.) Should face to face classes become cancelled, your money will be refunded or put toward the option of continuing learning virtually (see pp. 3-4), for a lesser fee. I will continue to provide an individual snack and a glass of water, but it is highly recommended students bring their own <u>water bottle</u> and possibly snack as well. I am requesting your address on the registration form in case I need to return money to you in the future.

#### Important Details:

- Cost \$120 for 12 one-hour classes.
- There is a \$10 discount per child for signing up more than one child.
- Classes are in the Spanish Room 211.
- Front doors close 3:15. Use Door G. for pick up at 3:30.
- Sign-up by Monday, September 14th.
- See p. 5 for registration form.
- Water bottle is preferred.
- Please <u>write a one-time note</u> for your child's teacher, including all the dates your child will attend Spanish class. I will also notify teachers on a weekly basis.
- Call me directly if you are running late picking up your child.
- Late sign-ups are accepted as late as the 3<sup>rd</sup> class, please notify me by email/text.

## <u>SPANISH</u> OR <u>GERMAN</u> VIRTUAL

Students are giving up many things during this pandemic. Learning Spanish or German should not be one of them. Therefore, I have created an entire virtual program for Spanish and German this past summer. It is set up that I send the week's lesson to each student, through Google Classroom, every Monday, with about one hour of Spanish or German activities (see below for details.) The student completes the lesson (no writing or homework required) at his/her convenience. The lessons would *continue for 13 weeks.* I have a Spanish program for readers and one for non-readers, and the German program is a blended reader/non-reader program. Using Google Classroom as a platform for providing students with weekly lessons allows that most students can complete the lessons without help from an adult.

### <u>First class is free</u>/no obligation.

#### What does each lesson look like?

Each week I send a teaching video anywhere from 10-20 minutes long. All the videos feature me teaching actual lessons. These videos are filled with songs, easy/basic conversation segments, animals, foods, colors, numbers, and more, with many opportunities for repetition and encouragement! To introduce the material, I used a mystery hat, my own pets, Mr. Potato Head, animal and food manipulatives, German/Spanish foods from my own cupboard, and more.

Each video covers a small but interesting cultural or geography section. (Learn to make an easy piñata.) I will be adding a Day of the Dead and Christmas segment as well. An added bonus is <u>Brown Brown Bear</u>, <u>The Hungry Caterpillar</u>, and other wonderful and useful books that I personally read to the students.

Each teaching video is followed by a practice video and the option to pursue an array of links to YouTube for additional appropriate, fun, meaningful support to each lesson. I send just a few links each week, and they are specific to the week's lessons.

#### Important details:

- Weekly virtual materials will be sent from Sept. 14th-Dec. 14th. (No virtual class the week of Thanksgiving.)
- Each new lesson is sent via Google Classroom on Mondays.
- The fee will be \$5 per week, first week is FREE (week of Sept. 14th).
- To receive the first week of free materials, just email me your student's name.
- To sign up for the Sept-Dec. program, please send a check in an envelope marked <u>Jean Winkel</u> and send it with your child to school by September 21st. Included with the check for \$60 (1st of 13 virtual classes is free) should be parent names, email, student name, grade and teacher, and include the type of program for your student. No special form required. Should you have a 2nd child taking the <u>same</u> program, the fee for the 2nd child would be \$2 per week, or an additional \$24.

Program choice are:

- -Virtual Spanish for readers
- -Virtual Spanish for non-readers
- -Virtual German blend of readers and non-readers
