



COMMUNITY SURVEY RESULTS

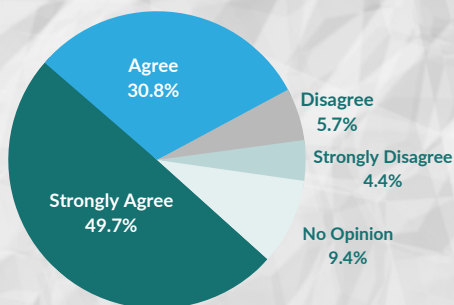
FALL 2023

The North Lake School District is considering an operational referendum in April 2024. As part of this effort, the North Lake School Board conducted a survey to gather feedback from community members about a possible referendum to address the district's needs.

Below are some key takeaways from the September 24 - October 20, 2023 community-wide survey. A total of 159 community members participated in the survey.

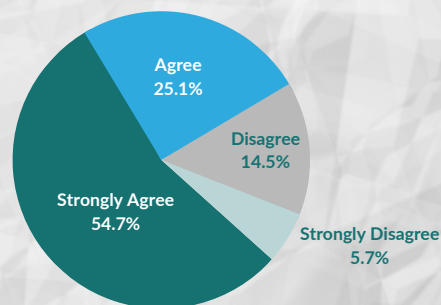
I am satisfied with the North Lake School District.

80.5% agreed or strongly agreed with this statement.



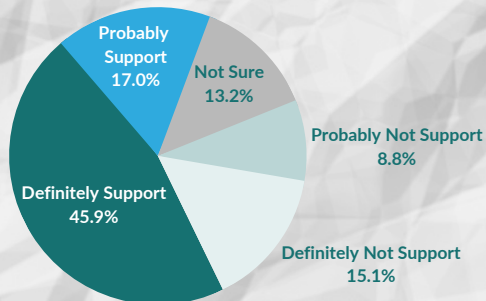
I believe the district's most urgent financial needs must be addressed now.

79.8% agreed or strongly agreed with this statement.



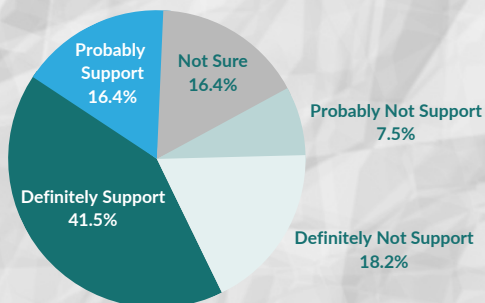
OPTION 1: I would vote "yes" on a referendum question to increase the revenue limit by \$850,000 a year for four years for a total of \$3.4 million if there was projected to be tax rate increases of \$110.28 in Year 1, \$103.32 in Year 2, \$96.80 in Year 3, and \$90.69 in Year 4 on each \$100,000 of assessed property value.

62.9% indicated they would definitely or probably support this option.



OPTION 2: I would vote "yes" on a referendum question to increase the revenue limit by \$975,000 a year for four years for a total of \$3.9 million if there was projected to be tax rate increases of \$126.50 in Year 1, \$118.51 in Year 2, \$111.04 in Year 3, and \$104.03 in Year 4 on each \$100,000 of assessed property value.

57.9% indicated they would definitely or probably support this option.
